


Take a front row seat



HOW TO FIND THE GOLDEN HIND

The Golden Hind is very easy to find. It's an extremely large pub set back off the road at a key junction North of the City on Milton Road, just a short distance from The Portland Arms.



If you're coming from outside Cambridge, it's best to approach it from the A14. Leave at the A10/A1309 turn-off and head into the City. The Golden Hind is on the right at the fourth set of traffic lights. There is ample parking space at the rear, accessed via King's Hedges Road.

The Functions Room is on the first floor - and is certainly our best venue yet!
