Bob Dylan and Eric Clapton gave a blistering performance to a sell out crowd at New York's Madison Square Garden during Clapton's charity concert on Wednesday, June 30 to benefit the Crossroads Centre at Antigua. The centre is an international, non-profit facility for recovery from alcohol and drug dependence, founded by Clapton in 1997.

## Bob Dylan Museum?

There could be a Bob Dylan museum in Duluth if a New York consultant gets her way.

Susan Phillips is meeting with Dylan's agents to discuss the development of a non-profit Bob Dylan Digital Arts Center.

Phillips envisages a privately funded centre that would feature Dylan's writings and paintings, as well as interactive media and a performing arts space.

An argument swaying opinion is that fans from around the world go to Duluth and find there's nothing about Dylan there.

Phillips says that Dylan's agents are receptive to the idea but they don't want a Dylan version of Graceland.

With all the talk about the remastered Street Legal it's worth looking at this snippet taken from the David Mansfield website (<http://members.aol.com/smashprod/>). It underlines just how much the clean-up crew at Columbia had to do to improve the album, and just how impossible it was to do a thorough job.

"Street Legal" *Columbia, 1978*

A great album, despite some poor sound quality due to the fact that, during recording, Bob decided that all the go-bos were interfering with the music and had all of us draw our instruments around in a tight little circle. The engineer and assistants scrambled madly to re-place mikes and deal with the dramatically increased leakage without missing too many of the songs (Bob wasn't into doing things twice at that time).

### HOW TO FIND THE GOLDEN HIND

The Golden Hind is very easy to find. It's an extremely large pub set back off the road at a key junction North of the City on Milton Road.

If you're coming from outside Cambridge, it's best to approach it from the A14. Leave at the A10/A1309 turn-off and head into the City. The Golden Hind is on the right at the fourth set of traffic lights. There is ample parking space at the rear, accessed via King's Hedges Road.

The Functions Room is on the first floor.
