Dylan is hitting the road with a dance band called The Brian Setzer Orchestra. News on the grapevine talks of seats being cleared from auditoriums and a poster (opposite) describes the night as a “show and dance” and promises “The season’s most exciting show!”. By the time we meet up – at The Golden Hind on Friday, January 29 – all will be revealed as the tour gets under way in Florida on the 26th.

News on the grapevine also talks of disappointed Dylan fans, who taped the BBC2 “Glastonbury 98” programme on New Year’s Eve, expecting to see footage of Dylan. According to the Christmas edition of the Radio Times, Dylan was one of the highlights at the summer festival. His name was mentioned along with others who appeared at Glastonbury and led people to believe that footage of Dylan was indeed going to be included. This illustrates the blind faith of some Dylan fans, bearing in mind the fact that it was well reported at the time that there was no official filming done of Dylan’s set. That said, I was one

HOW TO FIND THE GOLDEN HIND

The Golden Hind is very easy to find. It's an extremely large pub set back off the road at a key junction North of the City on Milton Road.

If you're coming from outside Cambridge, it's best to approach it from the A14. Leave at the A10/A1309 turn-off and head into the City. The Golden Hind is on the right at the fourth set of traffic lights. There is ample parking space at the rear, accessed via King's Hedges Road.

The Functions Room is on the first floor.
